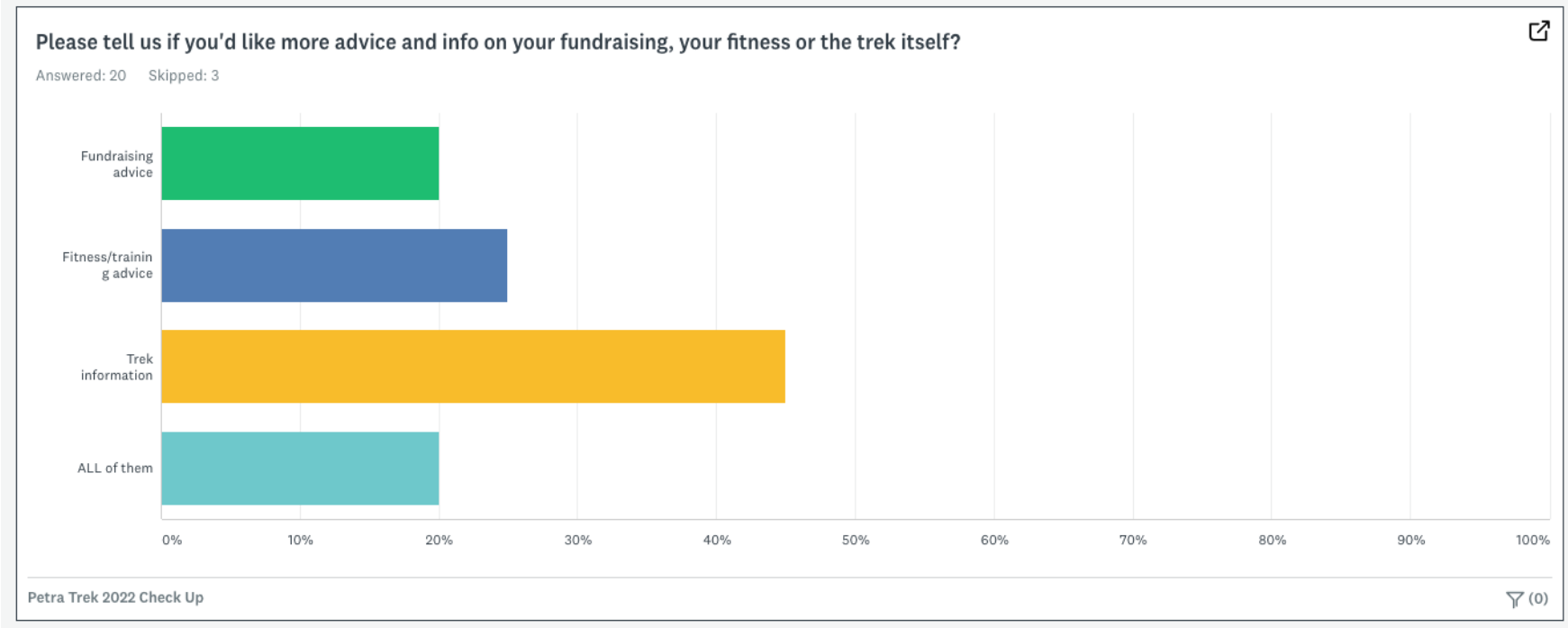

## TREK SUMMARY

**Grade** – demanding

**Duration** – 9 Days (6 days trekking)

**Distance** – Average of 95-100 km of trekking overall, around 11 miles and 9 hours a day

- Unique landscapes – from gentle hills, wadis and arid desert to the dramatic mountains, sandstone canyons and escarpments of Jordan's Rift Valley
- Finish at the ancient Red-Rose City of Nabateans – Petra

## What makes it challenging?

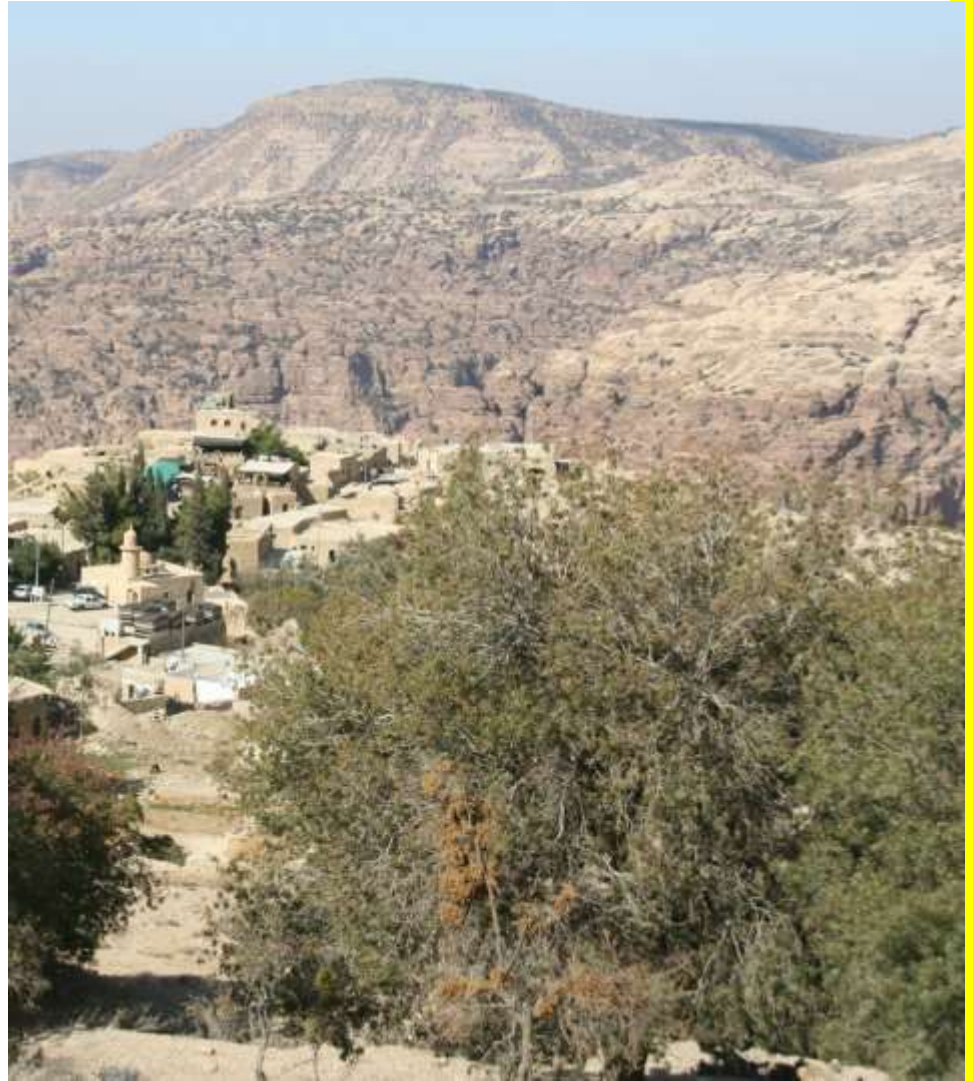
- Arid, hot conditions on the flat
